SPEIGHTSTOWN broke out a bit, sped to the early lead, set the pace toward the inside, inched away in the stretch and won clear under some urging. MCCANN'S MOJAVE stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, was between foes midway on the bend, continued off the rail into the stretch and was second best. PUBLICATION dropped back off the rail early then angled in, came out leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and picked up the show. CONGAREE chased off the rail on the backstretch, advanced three deep on the turn to loom a threat, lacked the needed response, then drifted inward in deep stretch and weakened. NEW YORK HERO stalked the winner between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside a rival leaving the turn and also weakened. SAINT WAKI dropped back without early speed, angled in early and saved ground but was outrun. PRIVATE HORDE squeezed back at the start, pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace on the backstretch and turn but had little left for the stretch.
