CLOCK STOPPER was outrun early, swung wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely outside but could not get to the winner. GATORS N BEARS raced close up early while in hand, rallied three wide nearing the stretch, could not handle the winner and faded in the final furlong. MIKE'S CLASSIC contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. GOLD DOLLAR was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. MY COUSIN MATT was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused.
